## Key Information



- PE lessons are on a Monday and Wednesday this half term. This will change each half term due to sports coaches in being school.
- Reading books, reading records and library books need to be brought to school each day. We will visit the library every other week on a Tuesday
- Homework for the Autumn term is to read 3x per week to an adult. From Spring term, children will also be set I piece of Maths or English homework on Purple Mash.
- The Phonics Screening Check will begin the week commencing Monday 10th June 2024.

## Reading and Phonics

We continue to follow the Moseley Phonics Scheme to teach your child to read. In year I we learn Phase 5 sounds.

Everything we learn will be checked in the summer term as part of the Phonics Screening Check.

We doing small group, guided reading 3 times a week.

During our whole class guided reading, we will read a book together across a half term. This half term the book is 'Beegu'.

## Writing

Writing is assessed each half term. We cover a variety of genres so that your child is able to write fluently and for a purpose.

A child working at the expected level should be able to do the majority of the outlined criteria, independently.

Name:

Combine words to make sentences orally and in writing.

Join words and clauses using 'and'.

Separate words with spaces.

Demarcate some sentences with capital letters and end with punctuation – full stop, exclamation, question mark

Use capital letters for names, places, days of the week and the personal pronoun 'I'.

Use basic descriptive language.

Sequence sentences to form a short narrative or piece of information writing.

Orally rehearse sentences before writing.

Re-read and check writing makes sense.

Use phonic knowledge and skills from FS and YI to spell some phonemically regular words correctly and make phonically-plausible attempts at others.

Spell YI common exception words (many).

Spell words with simple suffixes and prefixes correctly.

e.g. singular and plural 's' and 'es', verb endings 'ed', 'ing' and 'er', 'est' (many) and the prefix 'un'.

Form lower-case letters in the correct direction, starting and finishing in the right place.


Form capital letters and digits 0-9.

#### Maths

We follow the White Rose Maths scheme at Moseley.

It follows the concrete, pictorial and abstract model.

We spend a lot of time ensuring your child is confident in the foundations of maths to ensure success later on in school.
