#### Human Geography



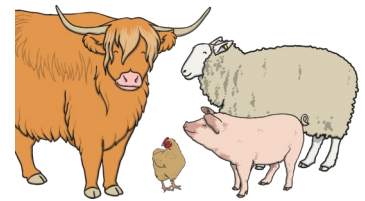
Features of the world that have been made by Humans.

#### Population

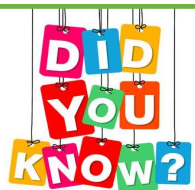


How many people live in one particular place.

The weather in Australia changes over the year. Australia also has four different seasons of weather.

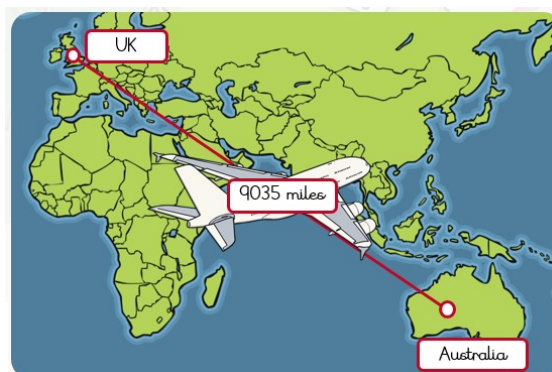


The seasons in the UK are at the opposite times to those in Australia

Around 65 million people live in the UK but only 24 million people live in Australia.
