EVENT MINUTE COUNTS

LATENESS = LOST LEARNING (Figures below are calculated over a school year)	
5 minutes late each day	3 days lost!
10 minutes late each day	6.5 days lost!
15 minutes late each day	10 days lost!
20 minutes late each day	13 days lost!
30 minutes late each day	19 days lost!

DANGER ZONE:

As few as 19 missed days over the school year reduces your child's chances of success. Your child's **SAT or GCSE** results could **drop by one grade across all subjects!** **Your child will be missing vital lessons.**



Children are expected to attend school regularly, unless there is good reason for absence.

The school has a duty to safeguard all its pupils. If a child is absent, the parents/carers should inform the school on the first day of absence and each following day of absence, stating the reason.

Parents/carers should ring the school office as early as possible on 01244 470860 to inform us of the reason for their child's absence. Alternatively Parents/carers can email school_admin@st-theresas.cheshire.sch.uk For additional support, Parents/carers can contact the attendance Lead, Learning Mentor or Head Teacher.

The Head Teacher is the senior leader responsible for the strategic approach to attendance in school.

The school office will make contact with home when a child is absent, and the parent/carer has not notified the school of the absence. If no contact can be achieved or the reason for absence is not accepted the absence will be unauthorised.
