We were extremely excited to receive the Asceed Accreditation for the next 3 years! Mental Health and well-being at the heart of our school.

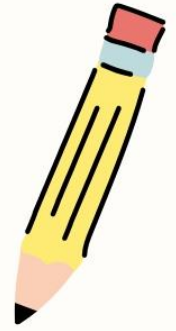

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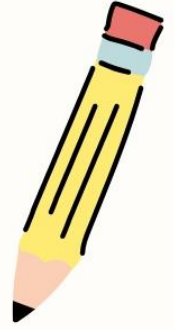
Adswood Superpowers - Each lesson and through daily life in school our children evaluate their learning and talk about the Adswood Superpowers. From focus, determination, kindness – a range of superpowers are part of our everyday life in Adswood and develop children's awareness of values and what they represent. Ask your child what superpowers they have used today in school?

Gold Standard – Each day children write in school, mainly in English but also across a range of subjects each day. We introduced the 'Gold Standard' 18 months ago and have seen a vast improvement in the presentation of our children's work – not just in writing but across other subjects. They take pride in their work and are always eager to share learning with other teachers, the leadership team and visitors. We look forward to sharing their books with you at our next Parents Evening in March. Ask your child about gold standard writing!
