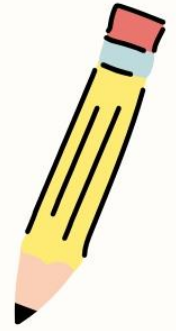

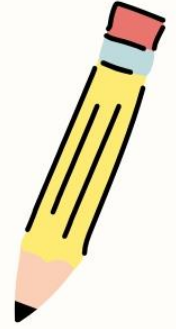
**Adswood Superpowers** - Each lesson and through daily life in school our children evaluate their learning and talk about the Adswood Superpowers. From focus, determination, kindness – a range of superpowers are part of our everyday life in Adswood and develop children's awareness of values and what they represent. **Gold Standard** – Each day children write in school, mainly in English but also across a range of subjects each day. We introduced the 'Gold Standard' 18 months ago and have seen a vast improvement in the presentation of our children's work – not just in writing but across other subjects.
