### A MESSAGE FROM MR LAVIN

The calendar for Spring 1 is on the next page. Thank you to our Key Stage 2 children for their wonderful Advent Service on Tuesday afternoon. It was a beautiful reflection on the true meaning of Christmas. The singing was outstanding. And, a big thank you for attending - it was so lovely to see such a huge crowd!

#### Building Work

I am pleased to confirm that the majority of the building work has now been completed, and we will be able to use the new spaces from the start of the spring term, following the Christmas break. Thank you very much for your patience while the work has been carried out. I have worked hard to keep disruption to a minimum.

I am fully committed to providing the very best classroom environments for our children and am delighted with what we have achieved so far. There is still some fencing work to be completed at the front of the school in January; however, this should cause minimal disruption.

The building project has involved relocating the main school office to the upper part of the school, creating new office spaces, and adding two new Year 6 classrooms. This work has also freed up additional space within the school, which is incredibly beneficial.

From January, access to the main school office will be via the Pupil Entrance gate on Chappell Road. There will no longer be access to the school through the current gate where parents/visitors buzz to enter the office.

#### Classroom Arrangements

- **Year 6** - Mr Fitch's class will move into the new extension you will have seen being built and will enter directly through their new classroom door. Miss Birtles' class will move into a newly created classroom and will enter through the new grey door.
- **Year 1** - Year 1 will move back into the outdoor building. Mrs B will be located on the left-hand side of the building, and Miss Leigh on the right-hand side.
- **Mrs Williams' Class** - Mrs Williams will move onto the Key Stage 1 corridor and will enter via the white door near the Early Years corridor.

Please do not worry - there will be plenty of staff available to direct you on Tuesday 6th January. Thank you for bearing with us as we move resources and settle everyone into their new classrooms.

I would like to thank you for your support this term. It's been jam packed and I hope you have enjoyed attending the various productions and nativities. Christmas is always such a special time in school and I hope we were able to share some of those experiences with you.
