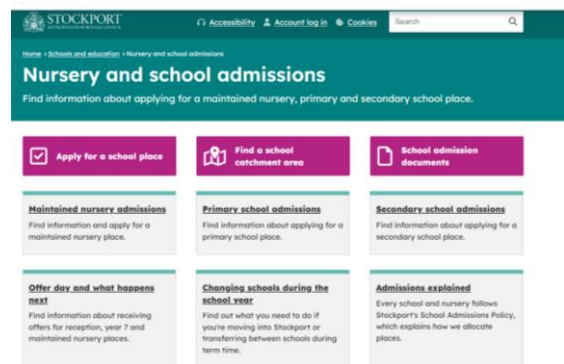
Nursery – January Intake

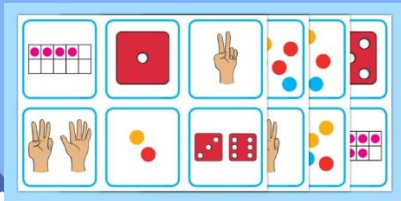

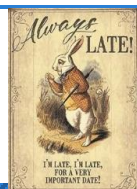
Boo the Badger
