This week, Nursery children received a postcard from the South Pole from a penguin called Jonty Gentoo. They have also looked at polar bear pictures in art. In Science, the children have also been melting ice to free the penguins.

In Reception, pupils have been reading the story of 'Supertato' and looking at superheroes. They have been weighing vegetables, thinking of superhero names and superpowers. They are also meeting with their Year 6 Reading Partners on Monday.

In Year 1, children have been planning and writing the build up to their stories. In History, children have looked at an old fashioned wash day.

In Year 2, children have been planting cress. They have carried on learning about the Great Fire of London and how it started and have been planning their write up in English.

Year 6 pupils have enjoyed playing netball in P.E. They have really enjoyed it and loved every minute of playing it this week. In English, they have enjoyed doing a 'free write' about a picture for their assessed writing.

Our assembly this week focused on Andy Warhol, an artist who was friends with Jean-Michel Basquiat from the assembly last week. Ask your child if they can remember how Andy Warhol became known by that name.
