KS2 Play Tickets

Class 4 Activity Day - Friday 10th July

Please ensure that your child brings their **water bottle** to school on Friday; a BBQ lunch will be provided but your child must bring their own (non-fizzy) drinks. They should bring a small rucksack which they will be expected to carry and look after their own belongings, including their packed lunch from home if they are not opting for the BBQ.

Your child should wear **long** trousers/leggings due to the long grass and midges, (no shorts as they will get eaten alive by the midges)!

The weather forecast looks good; please **apply sunscreen before school** and bring a **hat**. If your child is responsible and can apply their own sunscreen, they may bring it for reapplication later in the day. We will encourage them to do so. School does not have a supply of sunscreen.

Selfless Shelves supporting the West Cheshire Foodbank - **All in, bring a tin!**

We think that Capenhurst is a welcoming community that includes everyone irrespective of race, gender or religion.
