Fire Cracking Hot Dog and Ketchup

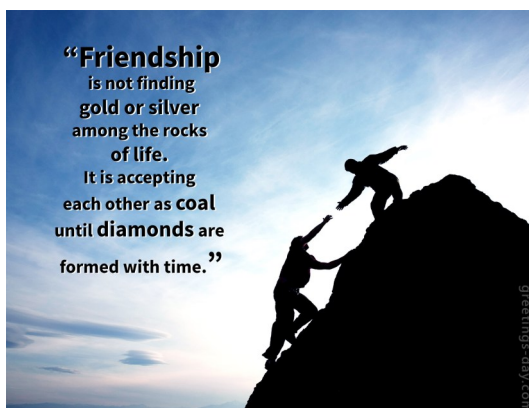
Catherine Wheel Pizza with smokey ridge fries

The children can choose this option on the day, no need to pre-book.

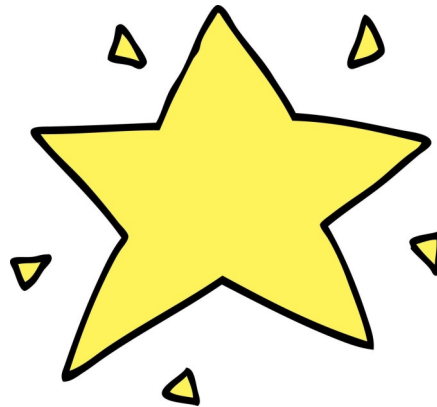


We had a very busy Celebration Assembly this morning with so many awards to present to the children. Thank you to all the parents for attending too.

We will discuss with the children what it means to be and have a good friend, here are some points to chat with them at home if you wish-

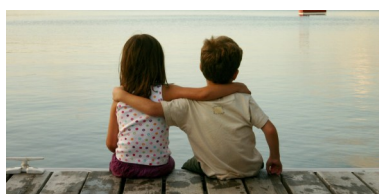
- Be supportive—offer help during challenging times and be happy for them when things are going well
