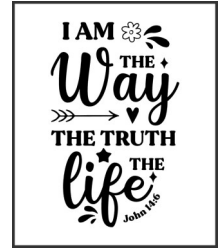

## Truthfulness

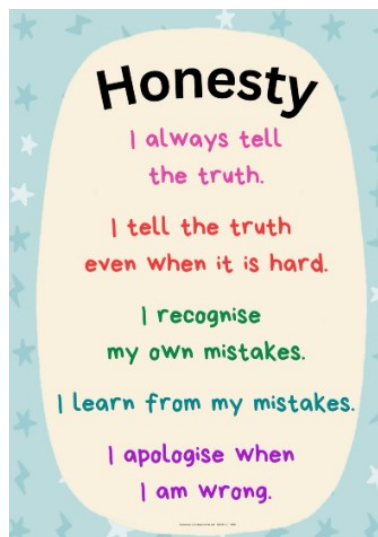
During this half term we will discuss with the children what it means to be truthful in all things, here are some points to chat with them at home if you wish-

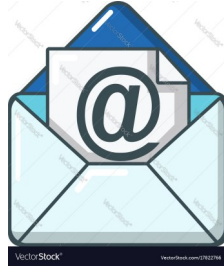

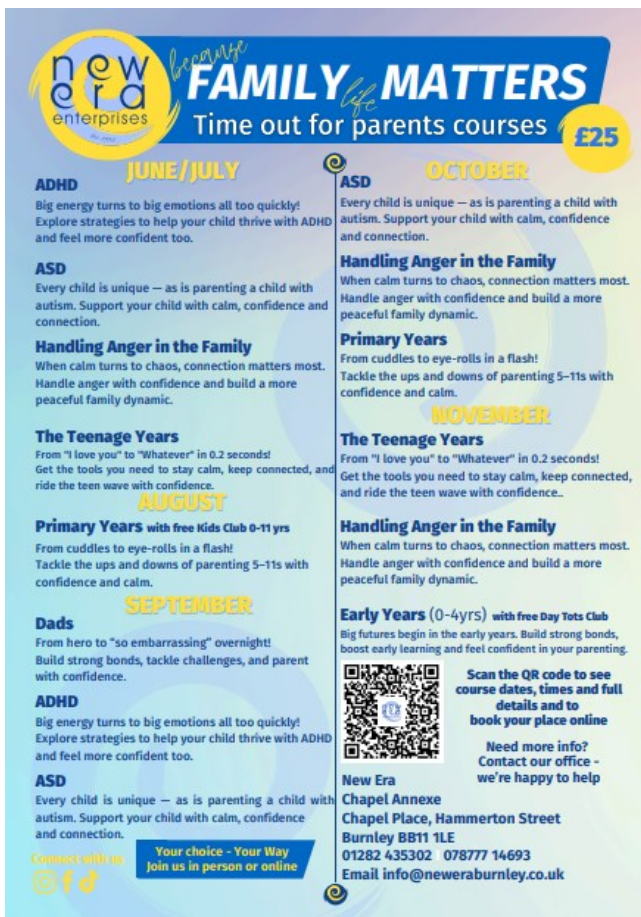
