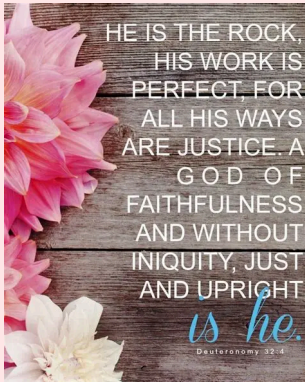

## Our Christian Value this half term: **Justice**

### The Good Samaritan (Luke 10:25-37)

A man was travelling along a road when he was attacked by robbers. They hurt him badly and left him lying there. Several people passed by, including religious leaders, but they chose to ignore him and did not help. Then a Samaritan—a person from a group that others often disliked—came along. When he saw the injured man, he felt compassion. He stopped, cared for his wounds, and took him to a safe place to recover. He even paid for his care.

### Justice Message

- Helping those in need
- Treating everyone fairly and equally
- Showing kindness, no matter who someone is

It teaches us that justice is not just about rules—it is about love in action.

### School Link

Children can live out this message in school by:

- Being kind to **everyone**, including those who seem different
  - Helping someone who is **hurt, upset, or left out**
- Standing up for others if they are being ignored or treated unfairly

# How to Set up PARENTAL CONTROLS for APPS iPhone

Apple devices come with built-in apps already available: Mail, FaceTime and Safari, for example. However, you can choose which apps and Features appear on your child's device and which ones don't. You can also manipulate the Features in Game Centre to enhance your child's safety and privacy when playing games, as well as blocking iTunes or App Store purchases if you wish.

### How to Restrict Built-in Apps/Features

- 1 Open Settings
- 2 Tap Screen Time
- 3 Tap Content & Privacy Restrictions
- 4 Tap Allowed Apps (you may need to toggle this to 'on' at the top)
- 5 Enable or disable the apps you wish to appear (or disappear) on your child's device

### How to Restrict Game Centre

- 1 Open Settings
- 2 Tap Screen Time
- 3 Tap Content & Privacy Restrictions
- 4 Tap Content Restrictions (you may need to switch the toggle at the top to the 'on' position)
- 5 Scroll down to Game Centre
- 6 Choose between Allow, Don't Allow, or Allow with Friends Only in the settings for each feature

### How to Restrict iTunes & App Store Purchases

- 1 Open Settings
- 2 Tap Screen Time
- 3 Tap Content & Privacy Restrictions
- 4 Tap iTunes & App Store Purchases
- 5 Select Allow or Don't Allow for each feature (you can also lock these settings with a password)
