

English

In English, we are reading The book The Tin Forest by Helen Ward. As we read the book we are producing some exciting writing including our own diary entries, letters, poetry and descriptive pieces.

Computing

In computing, we will be introduced to the concept of networks, learning how devices communicate. We will then be able to identifying components, learning how information is shared.

Maths

In Maths, we will be focussing on our place value skills so we can recognise the value of digits in numbers, order and compare numbers up to 1000 and solve problems using our skills. We will also add and subtract 3 digit numbers together.

PSHE

In PSHE, we are learning more about our emotions and feelings and focussing on how we can identify our different feelings and how to control them.

Physical Education

In PE, we will be learning how to read map symbols, use a key and orientate a map to help us solve map challenges around the school. We will also be learning how to play Tag Rugby with the help of Nelson and Colne Rugby Club. Look out for a future Rugby star!

Science

In Science, we will be learning about the three different types of rocks and through investigation we will identify the different properties and also learn about fossilisation.

Design Technology/Art
