#### What next?

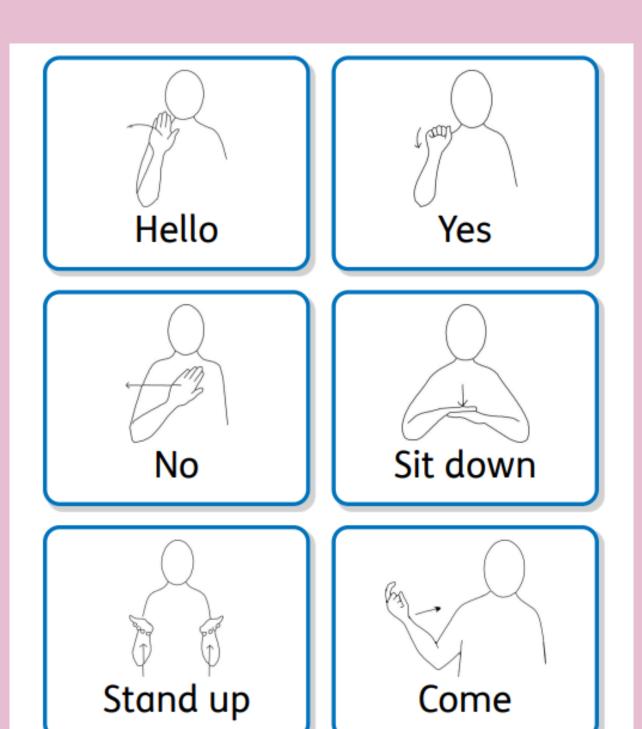

#### Reporting Absence Procedure for Parents/Carers
