

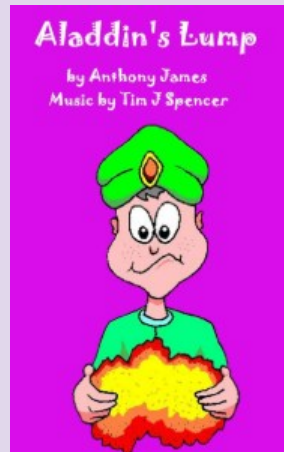

Children are to wear their P.E. kit to school, not just sports wear. P.E. kit is a white t-shirt with black shorts or leggings.

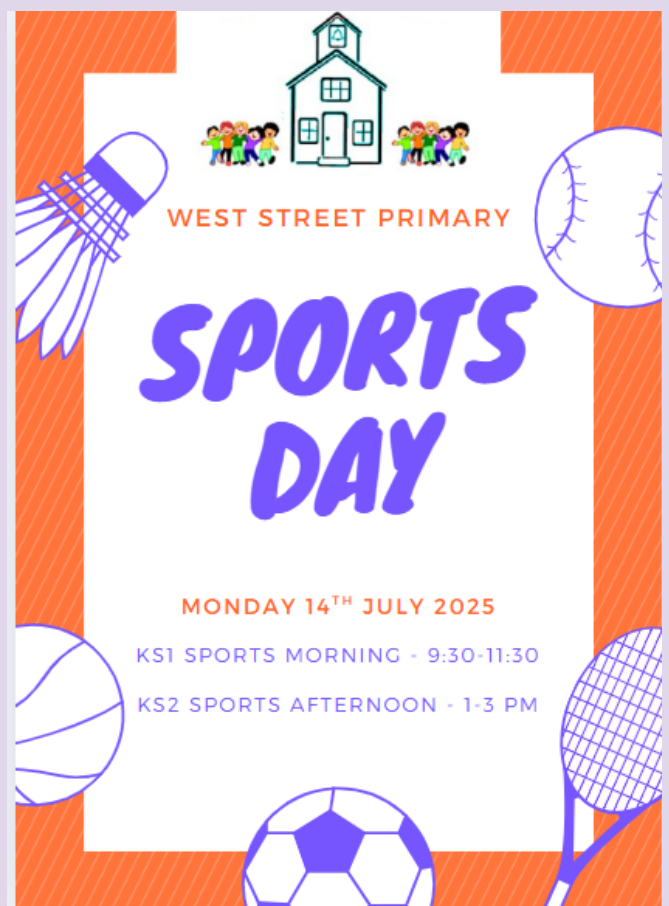
Trainers would be better for children to wear than P.E. pumps. Crocs are not suitable or safe footwear for Sport Day.
