After the service, the funeral cortege will drive past West Street Primary School at approximately 2pm. We would like some of the Key Stage 2 children to line the street as the funeral cortege passes by.

EYFS and KS1 children will not take part.

Parents are very welcome to join us to pay their respects.

We understand that this is a very sensitive subject and that some children may not want to take part so this is completely voluntary. Children who do not take part will remain in school with members of staff.

On Monday Key Stage 2 parents will receive a letter to give permission for their child to take part in watching the funeral cortege drive past.

After the service, Carol's family have invited West Street parents to join them at Colne Cricket Club for the wake from 3pm.
