1RB have been writing diary entries this week about their Christmas holidays. They worked together to write this diary entry about all the hard work they've been doing this week!

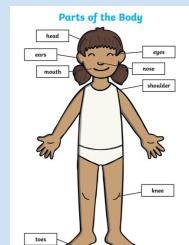
Dear Diary,

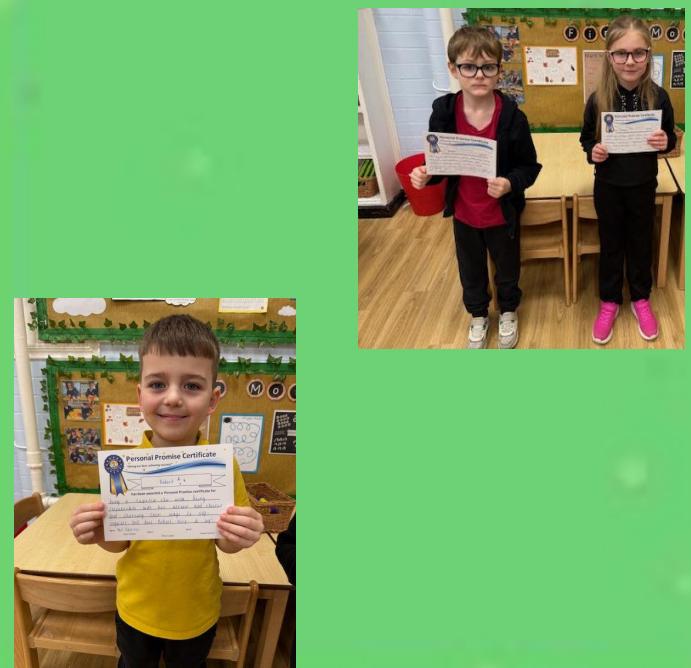
