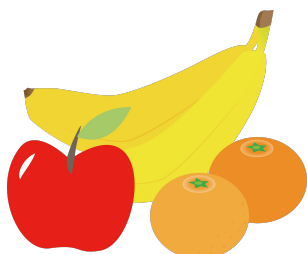
If your child has come home in school spare clothes, we would really appreciate these being washed and returned as soon as possible so they can be reused for another child.

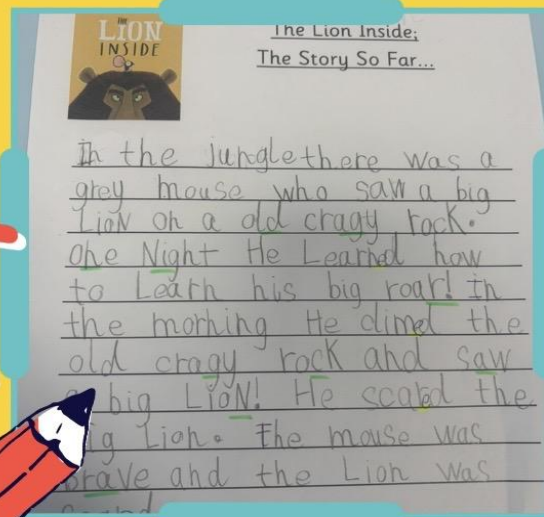
