What a brilliant week for one of our year 6 pupils! Hollie has won the 'Parents Player of the Year' trophy at her football club!

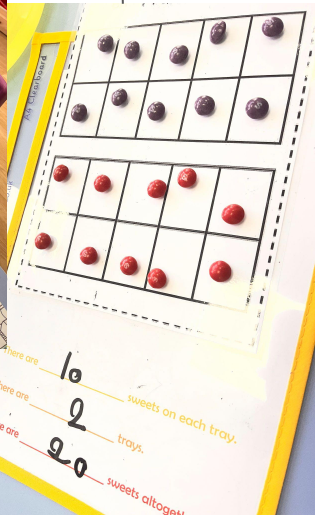
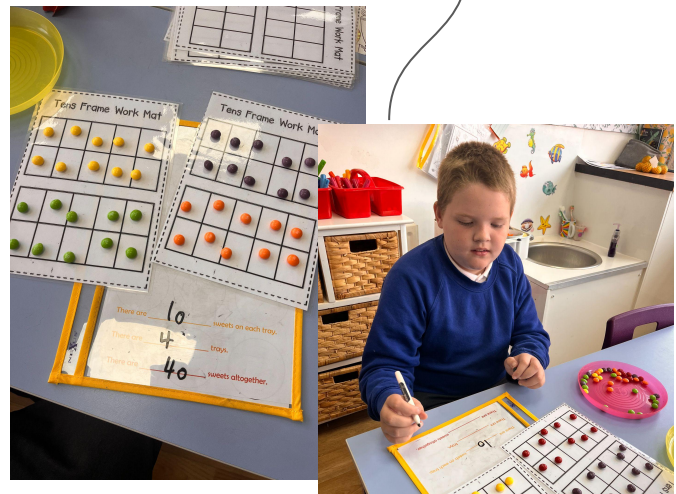


And also received our class star of the week award for some beautiful writing. Well done Hol!



## Maths in Hub 2SA

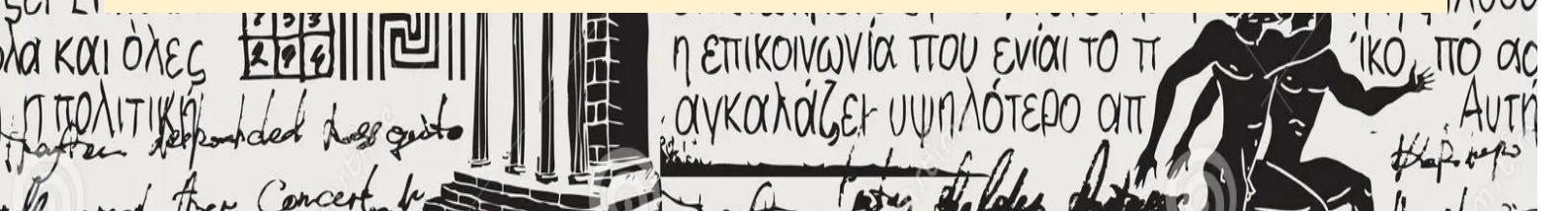
Some pupils in Hub 2 enjoyed using Skittles this week to help them count in groups of 10.



# Groundbreaking Greeks

Pupils in 5LC enjoyed an exciting and enriching visit to Liverpool World Museum as part of their Groundbreaking Greeks History topic. After morning registration, the class travelled by train to Liverpool, where they took part in two hands-on workshops exploring different aspects of Ancient Greek life.

During the sessions, children developed their understanding of myths, monsters and Greek gods, discovering how stories shaped Ancient Greek beliefs. They also explored what everyday life was like in Ancient Greece and Rome, handling real artefacts linked to pottery, daily routines and ancient warfare. It was a fantastic day of discovery, bringing history to life and deepening pupils' knowledge of this fascinating ancient civilisation.

Featuring: **Marvin and Milo**

I can make a moving snake.

What you need: • A sheet of paper • Cotton thread • Scissors

Cut a spiral shape from the paper.

Make a hole in the centre and thread the cotton through.

Hang your spiral above the radiator.

The spiral should start to spin slowly. The radiator raises the temperature of the air around it, so the particles move more quickly and spread out. This means the air is less dense and rises upwards. The rising air pushes on the paper causing it to spin.

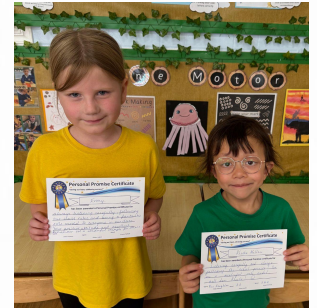
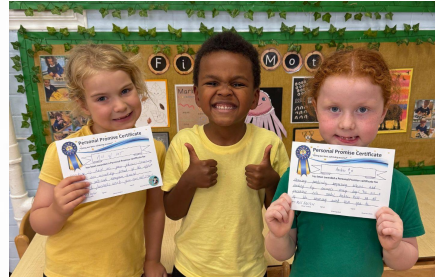

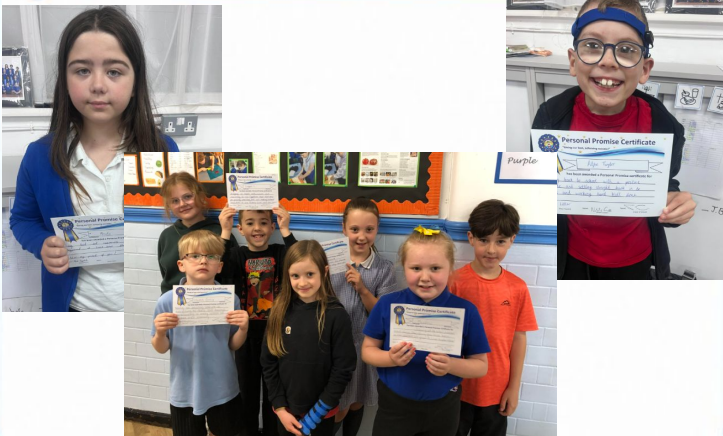
