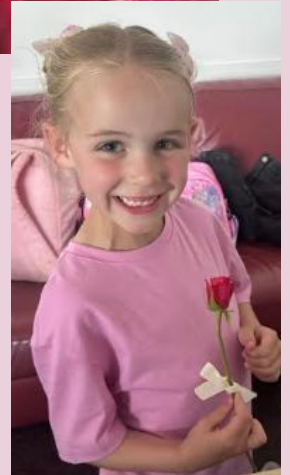
It was a fun-filled learning experience that sparked lots of curiosity, creativity and smiles!

Wirral School's Dance Festival

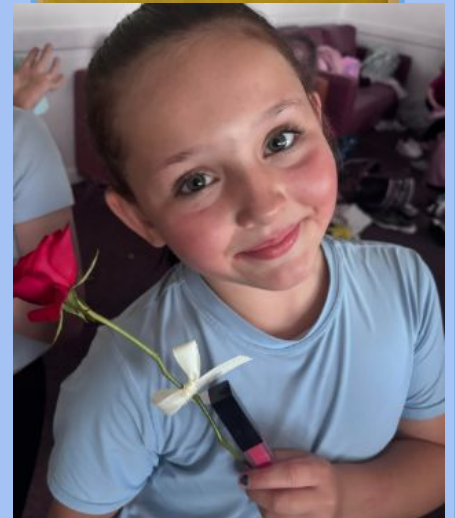

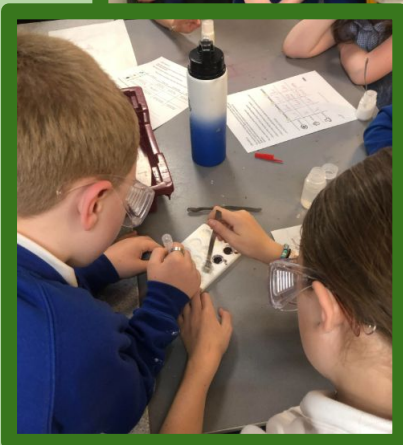
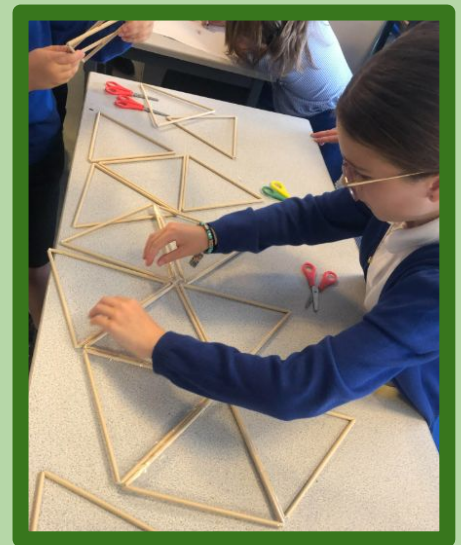
