Our Eco-Team, new wildlife pond area, kitchen garden, playground planters and rain catchers have ensured our success for 2026.

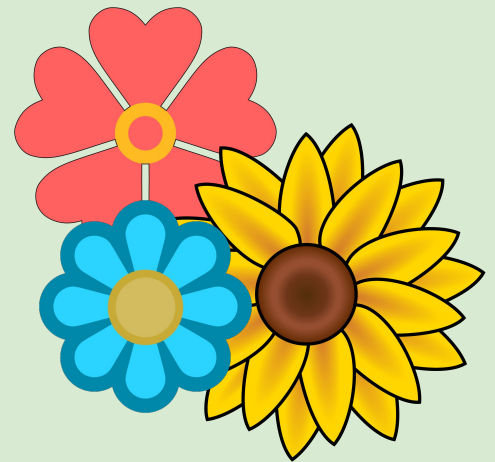
