English

This term we will be using the book 'Lost and Found' by Oliver Jeffers.

During our lessons, we will be making predictions, creating posters and finding out lots of facts about penguins.

The children will be learning to:

- Combine words to make sentences.
- Leave spaces between words.
- Begin to use capital letters and full stops.
- Use a capital letters for names, people and the personal pronoun 'I'.

We will be following the White Rose Maths programme of study and beginning the autumn term learning about place value and start work on addition and subtraction. We will be completing lots of our lessons practically using concrete resources.

Maths homework will link to the current learning objectives.

Reading

Children will complete daily phonics lessons using our Phonics scheme Little Wandle. Children will be assessed half termly on the sounds taught each half term. Each child will complete 3 reads a week. Each read focuses on a different skill decoding, prosody and comprehension. These books will be sent home on a Friday starting from the 12th of September. The children will also bring home a 'Reading for Pleasure' book. This book is to enjoy together as a family. This book will be swapped twice a week.
