Homework will not be sent via paper copies each week. If you wish to receive a paper copy of your child's homework, please let Mrs Dunning know.


We also love to see any posts on Tapestry about your children's achievements outside of school!

Your child will participate informally in these assessments in late June.




- Adults will change books on a Friday – links to the phonics


