# This half term's learning...

## Autumn one in Year 2

### English

This half term, we will be reading the book 'Troll Swap' by Leigh Hodgkinson. We will be learning to use past and present tense, expanded noun phrases and writing character descriptions.

Alongside our English lessons, we will be continuing with the final phase of Little Wandle phonics before transitioning into a Little Wandle spelling programme.

### Maths

We will be following the White Rose Maths programme of study and beginning this first term with Place Value before moving on to addition and subtraction.

### Reading

The children are continuing to read using the Little Wandle scheme. They will read at school 3x a week and their books are changed on a Friday.

Please remember to record any reading in their reading diary.

In addition, reading to your child and discussing stories/books develops their range of vocabulary and their love for books.

### Other information

Homework will be given out on a Friday via **Tapestry** and is due in on the following Wednesday.

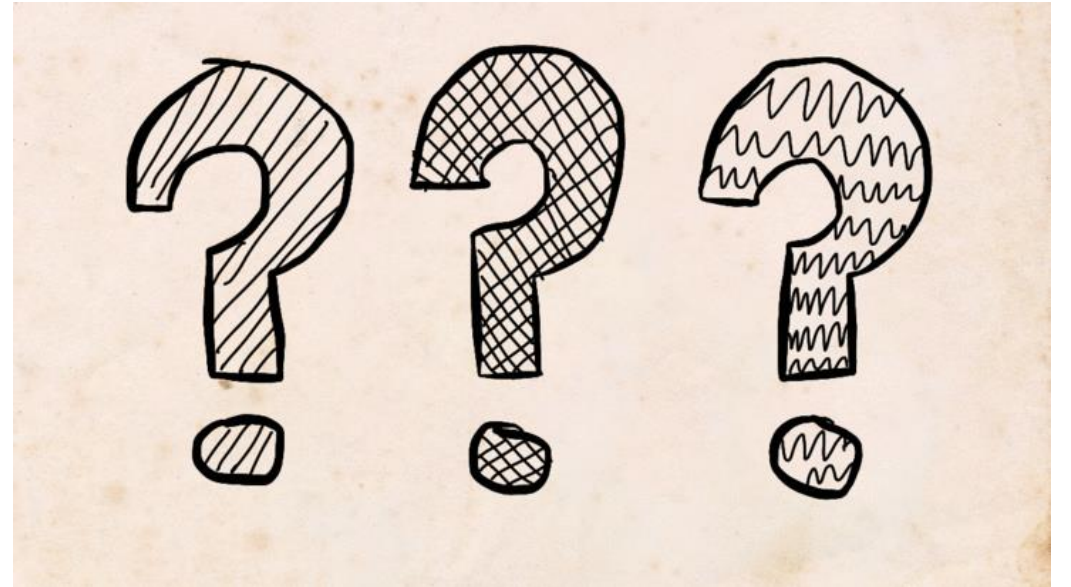
**Troll SWAP**
