English


We will continue to use "Drawing Club" to develop our mark making.

We will use stories such as "Naughty Bus" by Jan and Jerry Oke to inspire our drawing and writing.

The children will be learning to:

- *Segment and blend 3 and 4 letter words
- *Form lower case letters correctly.
- *Spell words by identifying sounds and then writing the sounds with letters
- *Write short sentences
- *Read back what they have written to check it makes sense.

We are reading...



Please come into school dressed in PE kits on **Tuesdays** for our PE lessons with Mr Gibbons.

In the afternoons, we will be learning about where we live and comparing this with London. We will learn about King Charles III, paint portraits and make junk models.

We will also be learning about winter, how water and ice change, celebrations such as Chinese New Year, and how to keep ourselves healthy and safe.

Maths

We will continue to follow the First4Maths programme of study and will be comparing numbers using the terms "more" and "less", counting backwards from 10, partitioning numbers up to 5, finding 1 more and 1 less than a given number and making patterns.

Reading

Children complete daily phonics lessons using our Phonics scheme Little Wandle. This half term, we are moving onto digraphs "2 letters one sound" such as "ai" and "ee". In addition, the children read a decodable phonics book. Once they have read this book 3 times at school, they will bring it home to share with you too!

Children also bring home a reading for pleasure books which is for you to share and read to your child. Each Monday, the Year 6 reading buddies will read and swap this book with your child so please make sure that they are in bookbags.
