English

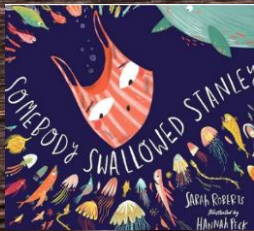
This term we will be using the book 'Someone Swallowed Stanley.'

During our lessons, we will be finding facts about sea creatures, describing Stanley's journey and writing about how we can save turtle.

The children will be learning to:

- Joining words and clauses using 'and'.
- Adding suffixes -ed, -ing, -er and -est.
- Use capital letters and full stops correctly.
- Punctuate sentences with ! and ? marks.
- Using the prefix 'un'.

Maths

We will be following the White Rose Maths programme of study starting with multiplication and division, and fractions.

We will be completing lots of our lessons practically using concrete resources.

Reading

Children will complete daily phonics lessons using our Phonics scheme Little Wandle.

Children will be assessed half termly on the sounds taught each half term.

Each child will complete 3 reads a week.

Each read focuses on a different skill decoding, prosody and comprehension. These books will be sent home once 3 reads have been completed.

The children will also bring home a 'Reading for Pleasure' book. This book is to enjoy together as a family. This book will be swapped twice a week.
