KEY VOCABULARY

Sight	Your eyes let you see all the things around you
Hearing	Your ears let you listen to all the things around you. Your brain is able to tell you what the different sounds are.
Touch	Your skin gives you sense of touch. You can tell if something is warm, cold, smooth or rough without even looking at it!
Taste	Your sense of taste comes from your tongue. You can tell if something tastes bitter, sweet, sour, salty
Smell	You smell using your nose. Your nose can tell if things smell nice or not.
