Dear Families,

Thank you for your continued support as we head into Summer Term! This half term we have really enjoyed learning about: Global Trade – how our products make it to Britain and it's impact on the world; Classification – Carl Linnaeus and how to group different species or domains of life and Cricket – how to bowl, field and bat effectively. Here is an outline of the curriculum coverage for Summer 1. Have a good and well rested break, and we look forward to another learning-packed term!

This half term, we will have a strong focus on English and Maths in preparation for the SATS.

We will be covering Electricity in Science and will be focussing our learning around the key question: How do we make circuits? In History, we will be focusing on the book, 'Black and British' by David Olusoga. This explores the rich history of black people in Britain from Roman times to the present day. This will also highlight interesting or overlooked stories or individuals.

Here is a breakdown of the skills and knowledge to be covered in each subject through this topic:

English:

Key skills: SATS Practise

Grammar:

- Word classes
- Clauses, phrases and sentences
- Formal and informal writing
- Prepositions and determiners
- Hyphens, dashes, semi-colons, colons and brackets
- Prefixes
- Passive voice

Reading comprehension skills will be a constant focus

Maths:

Key topics: SATS Practise including:

- Simplifying and equivalent fractions
- Adding, subtracting, dividing and multiplying fractions
- Missing numbers and inverse
- Order of operation
- Fractions, decimals and percentage equivalents
- Shape revision
- Long multiplication and division.
- Algebra
- Ratio
- Time and timetables

Science: Electricity

In Science we will be learning about electricity. The children will be building their own circuits and experimenting with different voltages and equipment. Please see the knowledge organiser to give you an overview of the topic and vocabulary.
