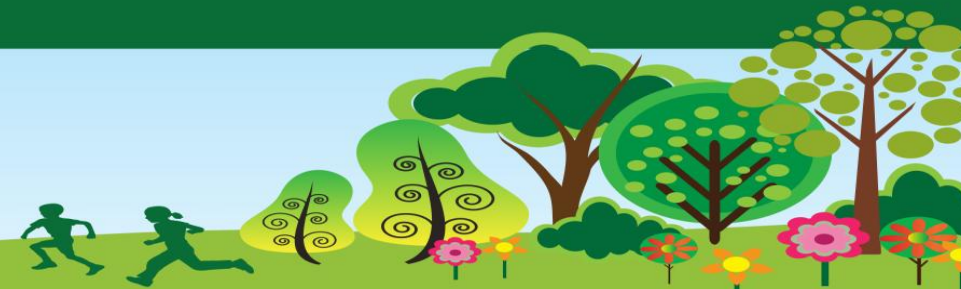

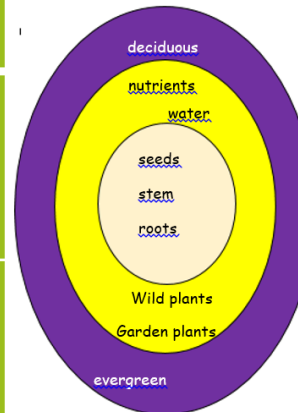


STICKY KNOWLEDGE

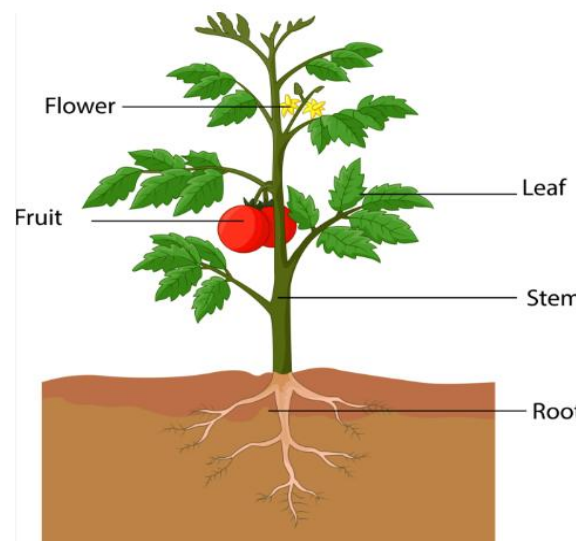
Seeds grow into new plants.	The parts of a plant are leaves, flowers, fruit, stem and roots.	Roots take in water and nutrients from the soil and keep the plant in the ground.
The stem holds the plant up and carries the water and nutrients from the roots to the leaves and flowers.	I know some wild plants are daisy, dandelion, and brambles.	I know some garden plants are rose, sunflower and sweet pea.

KEY VOCABULARY

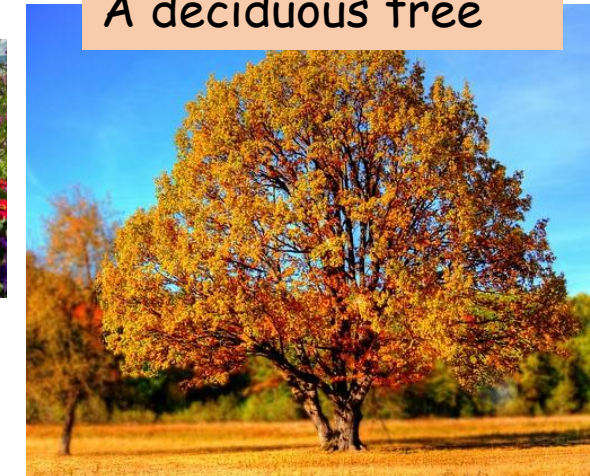
Plants	Plants grow from a seed. Plants need soil, water and sunlight to grow.
Wild plants	Wild plants are not planted by people, an example of a wild plant is a dandelion.
Garden plants	Garden plants such as roses are planted by people.
Deciduous tree	A tree that sheds its leaves and changes with the season.
Evergreen tree	A tree that remains green all year round.
