Here is a breakdown of the skills and knowledge to be covered in each subject through this topic:

English:

Our English, next half term, will be based around the books: *The Tempest* and *The Giver*. The children will be analysing the text before creating balanced arguments, rewriting a modern version and a narrative based on the classic story.

Maths:

Over the next half term, the children will continue to develop their understanding business acumen with Theme Park Maths as well as the Business Challenge. They will be financial planning including, costings, unit prices, budgeting, expected profits and then calculating their profit and loss. Finally, they will have opportunity to calculate their gross and net profits.
