Our World and the Weather



In the Resource Base, we teach through the Engagement Model and Intensive Interaction. We use child's interests to tailor our curriculum.

Below we have used the 7 areas of learning from the EYFS Curriculum to share with you what we will be learning in school and how you can help at home.

Personal, Social & Emotional Development

- Expressing a range of emotions
- Looking back for reassurance when leaving a familiar person (leaving family of a morning)
- Establish a sense of self

How can you help me at home?

- Allow me to express myself in different appropriate ways
- Support me in leaving you at school

Communication and Language/ Literacy

- Enjoy listening to music
- Build up a bank of likes and dislikes in my new classroom
- Focus on an activity of my own choice
- Copy facial expressions

How can you help me at home?

- Encourage me to copy facial expressions
- Allow me to focus on an activity
- Playing music for me to listen

Physical Development

- Go up and stairs, or climb apparatus, using alternative feet
- Use large-muscle movements to wave flags and streamers, paint and make marks
- I can gain control of my whole body through continual practice of large movements, such as, waving kicking, rolling, crawling and walking

How can you help at home?

- Climb up apparatus safely
- Encourage me to travel in different ways

Understanding the World

- I can explore collections of materials with similar and/or different properties
- I can walk as independently as possible in school, with adult support
- I can walk as independently as possible outside of school.

How can you help me at home?

- Encourage me to explore materials
- Walking safety in different in ways in different environments

Expressive Arts and Design

- I can explore different materials, using my senses to investigate them.
- I can move and dance to music.
- I can develop gross motor skills using large play equipment

How can you help at home?

- Encourage me to explore my senses
- Encourage me to dance to music (you can model if you want to)

Mathematics

- Days of the week song
- Number songs
- I can experiment with their own symbols and marks as well as numerals
- I can select shapes appropriately: flat surfaces for building

How can you help at home?

- Encourage me to problem solve
- Watching number related videos
- Mark making
