Children join this group directly as three-year olds on their third birthday or move up from Owlets group at the beginning of the term following their third birthday.

Recognising the first principle of the EYFS, that each child is unique, children will be supported to develop from their individual starting points, with a focus on developing their skills within the three Prime Areas of Learning of the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS): Communication and Language; Personal, Social and Emotional Development; Physical Development.

Activities linked to the above themes across the year will support children to develop their knowledge, skills and understanding across the four Specific Areas of Learning of the EYFS: Literacy; Mathematics; Understanding the World; Expressive Arts and Design.

As the children develop their skills, knowledge and understanding across the Prime areas of Learning, there will be an increasing focus on the four Specific areas of learning.
