


Little Lambs Settling in Survey - Results - 2025


Great, fast communication!




Additional comments: Parents shared that their children enjoyed the play and stay sessions and found them helpful for supporting a smooth transition into the EYFS unit. Some parents noted that they had not met the Reception teacher during the session and that a few additional sessions would have been beneficial. Others appreciated the school's effort in arranging alternative days when the main session could not be attended.

For clarity, the EYFS unit (Reception and Nursery) is led by Mrs. Ayrton, who is the Reception teacher and Unit Manager, who oversees and supports the highly experienced and qualified staff within the unit. We routinely offer one play and stay session per child; however, if families feel their child would benefit from additional sessions, this can be discussed on a case-by-case basis. Due to capacity, we are unable to offer more than one session as standard.


I feel that I had enough information to support my child when starting Nursery


Yes definitely and my little boy talks about them fondly all the time.




Additional comments:

He sometimes says he's excited for the day.


My child feels safe in Nursery and within the Early Years Unit




