Reception's Summer Term Trip to Cannon Hall, Barnsley – Tuesday 19th May 2026

To bring our farm topic to life, we are excited to be taking our Reception children on a trip to Cannon Hall Farm, where they will have the opportunity to see and learn about farm animals up close.

We have booked a coach to leave school at approximately 9.15am to arrive at Cannon Hall Farm, Barnsley at approximately 10:15am. The 1 hour guided tour will begin at 12.30am. It is important that the children arrive at school by 8.45am to avoid any delays to our day.

Before and after our guided tour, the children will also have some time to explore Cannon Hall Farm together. This will give them the opportunity to look at more of the animals. Explore different areas of the farm and, time permitting, enjoy a little play too! We aim to be on the coach by 2.30pm. Our estimated arrival time back in school will be 3:30pm and if this changes on the day due to traffic, parents will be informed via school spider.

The cost of the trip is **£16.00** per child and we are asking parents and carers for a voluntary donation to cover these costs and payment is now available on School Spider and should be made by Monday 18th May. The BSA have very kindly agreed to pay for half of the coach fees which significantly reduces the costs. If your child would like to go but you are unable to meet the cost of their trip, please do get in touch with us, in confidence.

All children will require a packed lunch for the day. **Those children who currently have school dinners will be provided with a packed lunch from school on the morning of the trip, the children have already chosen their lunch for this day.** School prepared packed lunches will include: a sandwich (children will choose from a choice of fillings in class), crisps, either a fairy cake or homemade biscuit along with a bottle of water. Children who bring packed lunches from home will be expected to do so on the trip day. Please note: we are a nut free school therefore please do not send any produce that contains, or may contain nuts. All packed lunch items need to be entirely disposable but no glass bottles please.

Please complete the school spider survey to give your consent for your child to go on the trip by Monday 18th May at the latest.

Please note, if you are in receipt of pupil premium funding, the cost of the trip will be paid for by school via this funding. However, please make sure that you still complete the consent form by Monday 18th May.
