Class 4 Summer Term Trip to Liverpool World Museum, Liverpool – Thursday 25th June 2026

During the Summer Term, we will be learning about the Ancient Egyptians in our Topic lessons. Therefore, a trip to the Liverpool World Museum to attend an Ancient Egyptian mummification workshop has been arranged.

We have booked a coach to leave school at approximately 9.15 am to arrive in Liverpool at 11.00 am where the coach will drop us off outside the museum. The mummification workshop will begin at 11.30 am. It is important that the children are at school by 8.45am otherwise this will result in delays and the centre cannot guarantee late entry, therefore we may miss our slot for the workshop.

After the mummification workshop, the children will be given time to explore Liverpool World Museum's impressive collection of Ancient Egyptian artefacts as a group. Our museum visit will finish around 2.15pm and we aim to be on the coach by 2.30pm. Our estimated arrival time back in school will be 4.15pm and if this changes on the day due to traffic, parents will be informed via school spider.

The cost of the entire trip is **£13.00** per child, we are asking parents and carers for a voluntary donation to cover these costs. Please pay by Wednesday 24th June 2026. The BSA have very kindly agreed to pay for half of the coach transfer which significantly reduces the costs. If your child would like to go but you are unable to meet the cost of their trip, please do get in touch with us, in confidence. Payment will be made via the School Spider online system – you will receive notification once this is available.

All children will require a packed lunch for the day. **Those children who currently have school dinners will be provided with a grab bag from school on the morning of the trip – if your child would prefer to bring a packed lunch from home please indicate on the survey.** School prepared packed lunches will include: a sandwich (children will choose from a choice of fillings in class), crisps, either a fairy cake or homemade biscuit along with a bottle of water. Children who bring packed lunches from home will be expected to do so on the trip day. Please note: we are a nut free school therefore please do not send any produce that contains, or may contain nuts. All packed lunch items need to be entirely disposable but no glass bottles please.

Please complete the school spider consent form to give your consent for your child to go on the trip, by Wednesday 24th June 2026.

Please note, that if you are in receipt of pupil premium funding, the cost of the trip will be paid for by school via this funding. However, please make sure that you still complete the consent form by Wednesday 24th June.
