## ADMISSION TO BARKISLAND CE (VA) PRIMARY SCHOOL 2026



Welcome to Barkisland School — where every child is valued, nurtured, and inspired to succeed. This letter outlines the events which will be taking place over the next few weeks so that your family has all the information needed to prepare them for starting school.

### Information Evening – Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> June 2026

I would like to invite you to an Information Evening at School in the EYFS unit (entrance located on Stainland Road) on Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> June at 6.00pm (for parents and carers only). If you are a current parent/carers in our Little Lambs Nursery setting and attended this information evening last year it will be a repeat of this session, there is no obligation to attend. The session will last approximately 1½ hours. **It is advisable NOT to bring children as there is lots of information shared and lots to focus on.**

The purpose of the meeting is to ensure that both school and you, as parents or carers, are able to share information which will help your child get the best start to school life. There will be opportunities for you to speak to some of our staff members and visit the classroom. Our main topic of conversation will relay how to support your child and their transition to Barkisland Primary School. This will include:

**Establishing routines:** Set regular bedtimes, meal times, and reading times. **Encouraging independence:** Let children practice dressing, eating, and toileting on their own. **Reading to your child daily:** Build vocabulary, comprehension, and a love of books. **Labelling emotions:** Help children understand and express their feelings appropriately. **Encouraging curiosity:** Answer questions and nurture a love for learning. **Modelling enthusiasm for school:** Speak positively about school and learning. We will send the PowerPoint presentation out after the information evening.

### FAMILIARISATION VISIT – FRIDAY 3<sup>RD</sup> JULY 2026

We have arranged a familiarisation visit for all children who will be a part of the Reception class on **Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> July, 10:00am to 2:30pm**. **If you would like your child to have a school dinner (£2.75, payable in cash on the day) on this date please complete this form: <https://forms.gle/zVp5kYnugPBBJhzx9>**. If your child is new to Barkisland, the pupil entrance can be found on Stainland Road (see map) at 10.00am. As soon as they are settled, we encourage you to leave them to explore the exciting classroom independently. This will give them chance to meet their class teacher and other staff who will be working with them and to get to know the classroom. Please return at 2:00pm to collect them from the pupil entrance on Stainland Road where you dropped your child off. **If your child already attends Nursery on this date then please drop them off as usual at the Nursery door and they will be escorted to the Reception classroom at 10:00am and return to Nursery at 2:00pm for collection at their normal time.**

## **UNIFORM**

Barkisland School uniform can only be purchased from school and will be on display at the meeting on **Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> June** and on the familiarisation visit on **Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> July**. Uniform can be purchased via our online system, School Spider, which we will set you up on after the Information Evening. **When your uniform order is ready for collection you will be notified.** Non-branded uniform in the same school colours can also be purchased from other providers eg., supermarkets etc.

We are fortunate enough to operate a before and after school club (Barkisland Kids Club) which is run by school. We are open every day from 7.30am until the start of the school day, and from the end of the school day until 6.00pm. ## **WEDNESDAY 2<sup>ND</sup> SEPTEMBER 2026**

**Children will start on a full-time basis on Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> September at 8.55 am.** From this date, they should be dropped off at the EYFS classroom entrance between 8.45 to 8.55am, which is accessed via the entrance on Stainland Road (opposite Barkisland cricket club field). This is where your child will be collected from at 3.30 pm each day. You will have the opportunity to become familiar with this part of the school during the Information Evening.

We hope the arrangements outlined above will help them settle quickly into school life and look forward to working in partnership with you in the months and years ahead.
