Reading Intent

At St James's CE Primary School, we believe that reading is at the heart of all learning. It is the foundation on which children build their understanding of every subject, enabling them to access the wider curriculum with confidence and independence. Becoming a fluent, secure reader is a vital step in a child's educational journey and is essential in nurturing curious, reflective and resilient lifelong learners. Our reading curriculum is designed to inspire a love of reading from the very beginning. In the early years, children develop firm foundations in phonics, giving them the essential skills to decode words and begin their reading journey with success. As children move through the school, they encounter a rich and diverse range of engaging, high-quality texts chosen to broaden their knowledge, deepen their thinking and spark their imaginations. We are committed to ensuring that all pupils become confident, skilled readers who not only master the technical skills of reading, but also develop a lifelong passion for books, stories and learning.

Big ideas in our Reading curriculum

- ✓ Text driven Reading units based around class texts
- ✓ A wide range of genres are covered throughout each year group to inspire and engage all learners depending on their interests
- ✓ Little Wandle reading scheme is followed throughout EYFS into KS1
- ✓ 5 Rs are explored in English units: Read and Explore it; Rip it; Rehearse it; Write it; Review and Edit it
- ✓ Reading purpose and audience: the children learn the importance of reading and how it enables them to access the wider curriculum
- ✓ Drama: children gain experiences through use of drama based on texts that they have read eg. conscience alley and hot seating
- ✓ After school reading clubs and young authors are carried out in school
- ✓ Reading challenges are carried in across all year groups to encourage reading to take place outside of school
- ✓ Reading is embedded into all wider curriculum

Links with other areas of the curriculum

- ✓ Everybody reads (reading across the curriculum)
- ✓ Maths e.g. reading reasoning and problem-solving questions, reading and analysing data
- ✓ Topic books available in book corners
- ✓ British Values (mutual tolerance, respectful attitudes, rule of law, individual liberty and democracy)
