Dear Quinta Families,

### **Entry and Exit**

To help us manage attendance, we ask that all parents complete the

Sports Day Registration Form. This form will allow you to specify which spectators you are authorising to attend - if not completed access will not be granted to this event.

Access to the event will be through the gate closest to Preschool. This entrance and exit will be monitored at all times, and attendees will be checked in and out against the names provided on the registration form.
