Remembering your child's items

Please make sure that you deliver children to school with all of their belongings for the day. Forgetting items can cause your child to worry unnecessarily.

Further to this, if the office are requested to take your child's items down to the class room this disturbs their lessons and ultimately their learning.



Extra Curricular Clubs

We have had an amazing take-up of Extra Curricular Clubs thank you.

You should be contacted before Monday if your child has been successful on getting on to a club. If they were unsuccessful this time their name will be held on a waiting list, and should a place become available, they will be contacted.

Please ensure that the staff member in charge is notified if your child is unable to attend a club or wants to stop attending a club for any reason. We need to account for the children on our lists and do not want to spend time chasing up missing children.

If your child does not attend an afterschool club a message will be sent to the office and they will contact you to ask why your child is not in attendance.

Your child will be removed from the club after 2 non-attendances, if they fail to let the staff member know they will not be attending.



Reminders: School Meals and Club Bookings via Scopay

Please remember to order your child's meals on Scopay. The current menu will remain the same until Christmas, so no changes are expected until then.

Breakfast Club and After School Club can also be booked via Scopay. Please note that there is no booking lock, so you can make or amend bookings at any time.



GP and dental appointments

Where possible, please arrange GP and dental appointments outside of school hours. We understand this isn't always feasible, but avoiding disruption to the school day helps maintain consistent learning.

The Department for Education reports that medical and dental appointments are a leading cause of authorised absences in UK schools. Even short absences can impact progress, especially in core subjects.

If an appointment during the school day is unavoidable, please inform the school in advance and provide appointment evidence (e.g. a confirmation text or letter).

Thank you for your support in helping us prioritise your child's education.

"The Quinta Primary School takes the safeguarding of our pupils very seriously. We are keen to offer the best support possible to all our pupils and through Operation Encompass we will be able to provide the best possible support."





Dear Parent/Carer.

Our school/educational setting is part of Operation Encompass which is a national scheme that operates jointly between schools and police forces.

Operation Encompass is the reporting to schools, prior to the start of the next school day, when a child or young person has experienced domestic abuse.

As a school/educational setting we have ensured that a member of our staff, (Designated Safeguarding Lead) known as a Key Adult, has been trained in the Operation Encompass procedures allowing us to then use the information that has been shared, in confidence, to support the child/ren in our care.

The Domestic Abuse Act 2021 identifies children who experience domestic abuse as victims of domestic abuse in their own right.

On 24 May 2024 Royal Assent was granted to The Victims and Prisoners Act. The Act placed Operation Encompass into Law.

This places a statutory obligation on police forces to share Operation Encompass notifications with schools/educational settings.

We are keen to offer the best support possible to all our pupils and through Operation Encompass we will be able to provide the best possible support to our children.

PENALTY NOTICE FINES FOR SCHOOL ATTENDANCE ARE CHANGING!

With the introduction of the new National Framework for Penalty Notices, the following changes will come into force on 19 August 2024.

Penalty Notices will be issued for

Term time leave: Penalty Notice fines will be issued for term time leave of 5 or more consecutive days.

10 Sessions of Unauthorised absence in a rolling 10 week period: A Penalty Notices may be considered when there have been 10 sessions of unauthorised absences in a 10 week period.

However, we retain the discretion to issue a Penalty Notice before the threshold is met. For example, where parents are deliberately avoiding the national threshold by taking several term time holidays below the above thresholds.

Per Parent/Per Child

Penalty Notice fines will continue to be issued per parent per child. For example: 3 siblings absent for term time leave, would result in each parent receiving 3 separate fines.

First Offence

The first time a Penalty Notice is issued for term time leave or irregular school attendance the fine will be charged at:

£160 per parent, per child if paid within 28 days of the issue, reducing to £80 per parent, per child if paid within 21 days.

(Unpaid penalty notices may result in a parental prosecution)

Second Offence

Where it is deemed appropriate to issue a second penalty notice to the same parent for the same pupil within 3 years of the first penalty notice, for either term time leave or irregular attendance the second penalty notice will be charged at:

£160 if paid within 28 days. (Unpaid penalty notices may result in a parental prosecution)

Third Offence

On the third time that an offence is committed within 3 years of the first penalty notice for either a term time leave or irregular attendance a penalty notice will not be issued. The case may proceed to Parental Prosecution under the Single Justice Procedure. If found guilty of the offence of 'Failure to send a child to school' the Magistrates can impose a fine up to £1000 or legal proceedings under Section444 (1a) can include a fine of up to £2500.

Dance Classes After School



BALLET AND CREATIVE DANCE CLASS



Creative Dance for Early Years is an innovative dance syllabus, created by Rambert Grades. Each dance class will take the children on an imaginative journey with endless themes. An energetic warm up is followed by physical skills development as the children learn structured movement material. Creative intuition is encouraged with a closing creative exploration to dive deep into their imagination. Swimming with whales, flying rockets to the moon or adventuring through the desert- every class is different!

Each session will explore movement in a new way and help to develop physical skills, harness musicality and empower confidence in young children.

Each child will have the opportunity to work towards taking a Rambert Grades Creative Movers exam, which are a celebration of each student's progress at the end of each grade. Each child is rewarded with a bright fabric badge and a certificate.
