## **The School Day**

The main school gates open at 8:20am and children need to be in school, ready to learn by 8:30 am. Children arriving late will need to register at the school office. School finishes at 3:00 pm. If you are booking holidays you will find the term dates for the next academic year on our school website.

## **Attendance**

High attendance at school is not just valuable, it's essential. It gives children the best possible chance of developing secure friendships, feeling safe, building on prior learning and succeeding academically. There is a proven link between high attendance and doing well at school.

At St Martins we promote the importance of high attendance in our weekly celebration assembly, awarding 'Attendance Bear' to the class with the highest attendance for that week.

As a school we strive for a goal of 100% attendance however we do recognise that there will be times when children are not well enough to be in school. ## **Learning Narrative**

This term, we will be learning about the continents and oceans of the world in geography which will also inspire an art project focussed on creating seascapes through the use of paint and brush strokes. In Science, we will be learning about materials and exploring their suitability for a range of purposes. In RE, we will be learning about how Christians hold belief in Jesus and his Good News.

During the second part of the term, in our Design and Technology (D&T) lessons we are learning about how wheels and axles work to make vehicles move - we shall have a go at making our own prototypes! In history, we shall be learning about the endeavours of famous explorers such as Captain Scott and Francis Drake.



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## Home Learning

### Reading

Your child will bring home to read either a Little Wandle guided reading book or an AR book (further information regarding AR books will be sent separately).

Your child will bring home their reading book each **Wednesday** for a celebratory read. They will have already read this book in school and will really benefit from reading it aloud to an adult at home.

This is really important because it helps to improve their fluency and comprehension. Books will need to come back into school every **Friday**.

### Maths

As well as reading at home, each week your child will have a Maths activity. There will be a new activity each **Friday**. This activity will support the learning that we have been doing in our Maths lessons. The homework will also have a spelling/phonics activity directly linked to our learning in class for that week.

This needs to be completed and returned back to school by the following **Thursday**.

### P.E

Your child will have PE on **Tuesdays and Thursdays**.

On PE days, your child needs to **come to school dressed in their PE kit**.

PE kit should include:

- Black shorts
- T-shirt based on the children's family learning group or plain white t-shirt
- Black tracksuit bottoms
- Trainers
- School jumper to be worn over the top for warmth

Please speak to the office if you are unsure of your child's family learning group.

### Forest school

Finches and Swallows will have forest school **once a fortnight on alternate Friday afternoons**. Children need to come to school wearing their forest clothes (long sleeved top and trousers). Please make sure that they also come to school with a suitable waterproof coat and wellies in a carrier bag. The children will then need to be collected from the forest at the end of the school day.

### Belongings & Uniform

Please ensure that all personal items are labelled clearly. Even with the best intentions, children do lose things - having them named means that items can find their way back to the correct owner.

Fruit is provided daily for the children to have at breaktime, however you may wish to send in a healthy fruit snack of your own.



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Could you also ensure your child brings in a labelled water bottle that is filled with **water only**.
