



Year 1 Learning Narrative - Autumn 2025

R.E.

This term our key question will be 'What does it mean to belong to a faith or belief community?'

PE

Our focus this term is Running and Playing Games. We will learn different running techniques and apply these skills to play a range of different games.

English

Our first text this term will be 'Oi Frog'. Our second text this term will be 'How do you feel?'

Science

Our Key Question this term is 'What are bodies and what can they do?' We will compare humans and animals, sort them into different groups, and explore our senses. We will also learn about the diets of different animals including omnivores, carnivores and herbivores.

Computing

Our Key Question is 'How can technology help us?'. We will explore technology within our classroom, and practice our basic computer skills, for example using a mouse and typing on a keyboard.

Our focus for both of these texts will be constructing simple sentences both orally and in writing, and using capital letters, full stops and finger spaces.

Geography

This term we will be studying the local area. We will be exploring how Cranbrook has changed and grown over the last 10 years.

Art

We will be exploring the work of Andy Goldsworthy, and our Key Question will be 'How to manipulate a range of materials to create a sculpture.'

Maths

This term we will be looking at Place Value within 10. We will also run our Mastering Number program alongside this.
