

Year 1 Term 1 - Trains

English

In English, we will be reading lots of stories, including some traditional tales, which will help us develop our sentence writing and use of description. We will be focusing on our handwriting and punctuation in our sentences.

Maths

In Maths we will begin by counting forwards and backwards within 10, comparing numbers, looking at 1 more and 1 less. Then we move on to adding & subtracting within 10, looking at the two parts and the whole number.

Science


In Science, we will be learning about the Human Body, focussing on our five senses. Alongside this, we will be looking at the seasons and investigating and testing the properties of different types of materials.

History

In History we will be answering the question "Why are trains important to Crewe?" We will look at trains today and compare them to trains from the past. We will look at how the local area has changed, and the impact from trains.

Geography

In Geography we will be looking at how our school and Crewe are special. We will be creating maps of our school and the local area. We will be using compass directions - North, South, East and West.




Art
