


Nurture Parenting Programme

The key elements of The Nurturing Programme are the four constructs, or building blocks, of good emotional health: - self-awareness, appropriate expectations, empathy and positive discipline. Although the four constructs were originally developed within the context of parenting, as our understanding of the importance of emotional health has grown, we have realised that these constructs are the building blocks for all healthy relationships and are therefore fundamental to good emotional health.

The Nurturing Programme which is evidence-based and universal, puts connecting and building trusting relationships first. It is a relational programme which focuses on strengths, partnership and supporting personal power, our emotional strength to get our needs met and make choices in our lives.

We understand the impact of trauma and apply this understanding both to the facilitation of all Nurturing Programme groups and to the training to deliver these. With this in mind, all of our parent groups are facilitated by two Parent Group Leaders, both trained by The Centre for Emotional Health in the specific programme being delivered.
