- Hygiene poverty affects 4.2 million adults in the UK.
- To put this into perspective, there are 1.3 million people who live in the whole of Lancashire.
- Hygiene poverty affects the mental and physical health of people and it limits people's social interactions with friends and family.
- It forces people to make the difficult decision between paying for essential things like food and bills or buying basic toiletries.

We have a close relationship with The Lighthouse Community Food Share who also distribute hygiene products to our Whitworth community. The School Council would really appreciate it if you could contribute some hygiene products to school between **Monday 2nd February and Friday 27th February**, these we will deliver to The Lighthouse Community Food Share. Products must be unopened and unused.

- Deodorant
- Toothbrush/ toothpaste
- Shampoo/ conditioner
- Nappies
- Female hygiene products
- Washing powder
- Household cleaning products
