 Homework Help Place Value - The value of a digit depends on where it is in the number. - Example: In 47,326, the 7 is worth 7,000. Rounding - If the next digit is 5 or more, round up. - If the next digit is 4 or less, round down. - Example: 5,782 → 5,800 Fractions of Amounts $\frac{1}{2}$ means divide by 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ means divide by 4 - Example: $\frac{1}{4}$ of 80 = 80 ÷ 4 = 20	BIDMAS When a calculation has more than one operation, work through them in this order: B = Brackets I = Indices (powers) D = Division M = Multiplication A = Addition S = Subtraction Remember: Division and multiplication come before addition and subtraction. Example 1: $5 \times 9 + 7$ $= 45 + 7$ $= 52$ Example 2: $12 \times 4 - 6$ $= 48 - 6$ $= 42$
