
As **Writers**, we will use our class text The Iron Man by Ted Hughes to:

Number: Addition and Subtraction

- Investigating addends and subtrahends.
- Using place value to set out column addition and subtraction.
- Adding and subtracting 2-digit numbers.
- Adding and subtracting using column addition.
- Use addition and subtraction to solve problems.
- Add and subtract 3-digit numbers.
- Check the accuracy of column addition and subtraction.
- We will also be investigating the 2, 4 and 8 times tables.
- The relationships between those times tables.

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Our **Life skills** lessons will focus on **Economic wellbeing: Budgeting.**

We will learn about ways of paying, the impact of spending money, how to budget and jobs/careers.

In <u>RE</u> we will study **Salvation** by focusing on the burning question: Why do Christians call the day Jesus died 'Good Friday'?
Our Christian value for this half term will focus on **Endurance**.

As **Artists**, we will focus on **Anglo-Saxon Art.** This art topic links to our History topic. Our lessons will focus on:

- Masterpieces in metal— Sutton
- Anglo-Saxon designs
- Masterpieces in manuscript—The Lindisfarne Gospels
- Illuminated letters
- The Bayeux Tapestry

As **musicians** we will develop our listening, appraising and performance skills by focusing on the dragon song by Joanna Mangona and Pete Readman. This is a song about kindness, respect, friendship, acceptance and happiness.



How can I help my child?

Read with your child as often as you can asking questions such as 'why does the character feel that way? What clue tells you that?

Practise times tables – we are currently learning the 4's and 8's.

As **scientists** we will investigate **Plants** by focusing on:

- Botany and Flowering Plants
- Requirements for Life and Growth
- Water Transportation in Plants
- Pollination in Flowering Plants
- Seed Dispersal

By the end of the unit the we will be able to:

- Identify and describe the functions of different parts of flowering plants: roots, stem/trunk, leaves and flowers
- Explore the requirements of plants for life and growth (air, light, water, nutrients from soil, and room to grow) and how they vary from plant to plant
- Investigate the way in which water is transported within plants
- Explore the part that flowers play in the life cycle of flowering plants, including pollination, seed formation and seed dispersal

As **Technology users** we will continue to learn about programming using the programme **scratch**. The unit will teach us to:

- Explore a programming application.
- Use repetition (a loop) in a program.
- To program an animation.
- To program a story.
- To program a game.
