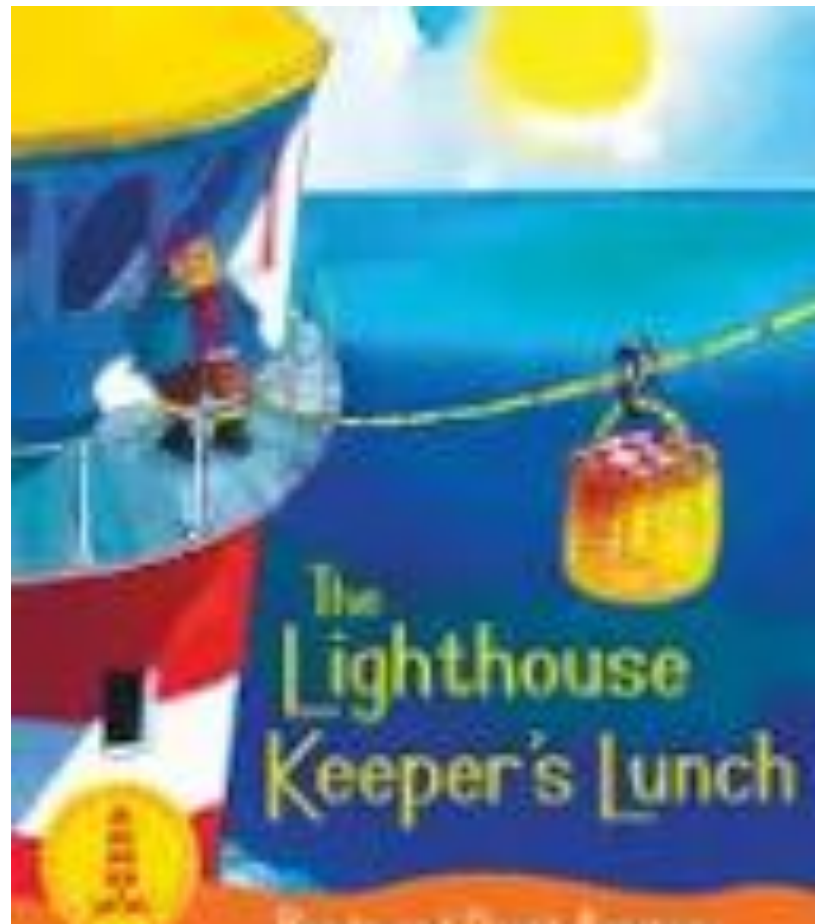

Behaviour - Be Ever Green

Green - All children begin on green & remain if follow expectations & are rewarded with house points, certificates. If Green all week, parents receive a text and children an extra house point!

Amber - Move to amber if a child doesn't try, disrupts, name calling, low level behaviour. This is an instant warning. Parents will be informed if a child is frequently on amber. Once behaviour is rectified then child goes back onto Green.

Red - Failure to improve after amber, physical behaviour (hitting, biting, kicking), inappropriate language.

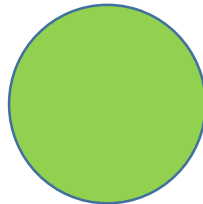
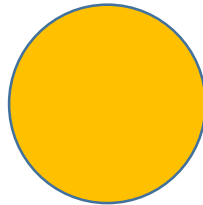
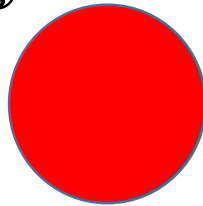
SLT & parents informed and notification of strike they are on:

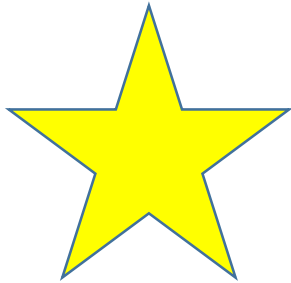




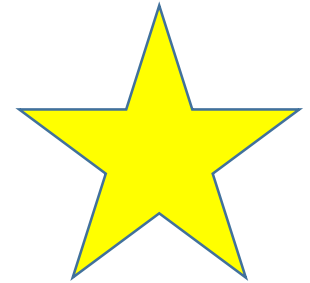
