LUNCHES

A school meal is £2.90 for all children, including Nursery. School dinners need to be paid for in advance as stated in the charging policy on the school website. SAFEGUARDING

It has been brought to our attention that some of the children in our younger classes, (below Y5 & Y6) have been meeting on Wadworth Street and walking into the school grounds from the bottom of the driveway rather than walked up the pathway by parents/carers. Staff are not responsible for children until 8.45am KS1, 8.50am KS2 and FS2 8.55am when they are collected by staff from the playground. Only Y5 and Y6 children who have signed consent should be walking up from the bottom of the drive alone. Please ensure to adhere to the above so that all children are kept safe at all times. In addition to this, at the end of the school day, please can you stand near your child's class line so that staff can see you and ensure your child is dismissed safely.
