We aim to keep costs for Nursery and wraparound at the Doncaster minimum rates therefore from 20<sup>th</sup> April 2026 they will be as follows:

3 & 4 year olds	£ 6.72 per hour
2 year olds	£ 8.64 per hour
9 months to 2 years	£11.74 per hour

7.45am – 8:55am – FS1 (Nursery age 3 to 4 only)	£4.80
After School Club	Cost
3.25pm – 4.25pm FS1 (Nursery age 3 and 4) to year 6	£4.50
3.25pm – 5.45pm (or part thereof) FS1 (Nursery age 3 and 4) to year 6	£9.00
Additional administration charge (Late bookings/cancellations/arrivals/collections)	£4.50

- 9 months of age up, of parents/carers who are working, entitled up to 30 hours free childcare
- All who are 3 years old under the universal offer to 15 hours free childcare
- 2 year olds with parents/carers not working and entitled to 2 year old funding
- All Nursery aged children, 9 months to 4 years, whose parents would like paid or extra paid hours of childcare for their child.

Please note the benefits of St Alban's Nursery:

- Our extended Nursery will be open 7.45am – 5.45pm Monday – Friday, throughout term-time.
- Parents/carers can use their free funded hours flexibly between 8:55am and 3.25 pm every day we are open.
