Safety arrangements for this special event

Everyone:

Due to safeguarding and health and safety reasons, the event will be a ticketed event and entry will only be allowed with a purchased ticket (like our usual Summer Fayres and Christmas events)

Parents and carers:

This is a normal school day that children are expected to attend until their usual finish time and we want them to enjoy it with their friends at school and then with their family at home time. Their performance for this event is their Grand Finale for the term, which is a culmination of their learning the second half of the Summer term. Although parents and carers may arrive before your child's performance, after their performance they will return to class and then at the end of the school day, they will line up as normal with their teachers and come out onto the playground for collection by a known adult at their usual finishing times of 2.55/3.25pm for Easby, 3.20pm for KS2 and 3.25pm for KS1 and Reception. The event will be continuing until 6pm, which will give you plenty of time as a family to enjoy all that will be on offer!

Tickets purchases and entry:

Tickets will be on sale soon, at £3 per person, including all children who attend secondary school or older. You will be able to purchase tickets from our Friends of School, through St Alban's Church or by purchasing them on Parentpay. Tickets will be sent home with your child.

Everyone attending the event will need to queue on the pedestrian walkway to the school playground. Gates will open at 1pm. Please hand in your ticket for entry and you will receive a complimentary programme as a souvenir. Monies raised will go towards something for school that we will be able to remember this special event by.
